



The characters \mathfrak{g} , \mathfrak{L} , and \mathfrak{F} have all become simplified when written as radicals, but as characters have retained the original traditional forms.

- Written as a radical, 1 is written as 1 in simplified when on the left side of a character.
- Written as a radical, 金 is written as 年 in simplified when on the left side of a character, but is still 金 in traditional. However, a few simplified characters retain 金 when not on the left, such as 鑫 xīn and 鉴 jiàn.
- Written as a radical, 言 is written as ì in simplified when on the left side of a character, but is still 言 in traditional. However, a few simplified characters retain 言 when not on the left, such as 警 jǐng 誉 yù.
